

HOW TO GET TO PINKERY

From Taunton the best approach is via Bishops Lydeard, Raleigh's Cross (ensuring that you fork right half a mile after Raleigh's Cross), across Wheddon Cross, and through Exford to Simonsbath.

In Simonsbath take the second left turn (signposted Barnstaple, Ilfracombe, and Challacombe), onto the road that follows the valley. After about a mile you begin to climb, then the road flattens out and descends again.

After a flat section you reach a sharp left-hand bend. On that bend a wooden gate on the right of the road gives access to our drive. Just inside the gate a reassuring sign says 'Pinkery Outdoor Education Centre'

Ignore the signs that say ' No Vehicles ' and drive up to the Centre, The car park is at the rear of the building

If you reach the Devon County Boundary you have gone 300 metres too far!

If you reach Challacombe you've gone too far!!

From the South or West reach the South Molton - Ilfracombe road, and take the turning westward that's a mile South of Blackmoor Gate. This road is signposted to Simonsbath.

After about three miles you pass through the village of Challacombe, and then the road begins to climb. Once it reaches the moor it flattens, and then descends fairly steeply.

At the bottom of that descent is a sharp right-hand bend, on the apex of which, on the left, is the wooden gate to Pinkery drive. Just inside the gate a reassuring sign says 'Pinkery Outdoor Education Centre'

Ignore the signs that say ' No Vehicles ' and drive up to the Centre, The car park is at the rear of the building

If you reach Simonsbath you've gone too far!!
