

Pinkery during Dark Skies Festival 2017

Pinkery Centre is owned and run by Exmoor National Park Authority and provides a unique residential experience right in the heart of Exmoor and in the core zone of the Dark Sky Reserve. Pinkery has been providing unforgettable experiences for young people since 1969 and continues to work with teachers and group leaders to ensure that every new generation is inspired by the landscape and atmosphere of Exmoor National Park.

During the Exmoor Dark Skies Festival 2017, we are offering the unique opportunity to book a room at the Pinkery centre on a self-catering basis.

Being primarily an education centre, the accommodation is in hostel type rooms with bunk beds - ideal for a low-cost October half term break. There are en-suite showers in each room and communal facilities including a large kitchen, dining room and common room. This is a quiet family-orientated rural venue. Own transport is essential.

Rooms are available for a minimum booking of 2 nights on the following nights:

Monday 23rd October

Tuesday 24th October

Wednesday 25th October

Thursday 26th October

Staying at Pinkery during these dates, you could make the most of the following events which form just part of the festival programme: Stargazing Evening and Talk at Lynton, Planetarium Sessions at Lynton and Dulverton, Big Adventure Day and Stargazing Evening at Webbers Post and a Guided Night Navigation and Stargazing Walk near Pinkery. The family could be entertained for hours!

The following rooms are available at the following rates (payable in advance and minimum 2 night stay):

Four-bed rooms – minimum £50 per night or £15 per person per night

Six-bed rooms – minimum £60 per night or £15 per person per night
