TAKE NOTICE that in pursuance of Section 22BB of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) **EXMOOR NATIONAL PARK AUTHORITY** has made an Order prohibiting all traffic from using part of Public Footpath between OSGR SS 6999 3494 and OSGR SS 7030 3573, that is more particularly described in the order and shown on the plan attached to it.

The Order has been made because of the likelihood of danger to the public due to a damaged footbridge.

The Order came into force on 26 April 2018 and will remain in force for six months.
