EXMOOR LOCAL ACCESS FORUM ANNUAL WORK PROGRAMME – SEPTEMBER 2005 TO JUNE 2006

- The provision of advice to landowners and users concerning open access land.
- Long-term Closure Orders, i.e. for more than 6 months and how these will be advertised and identified on the ground.
- A possible role for the Forum in asking Ordnance Survey to make a clear colour coded differentiation on its maps between open access registered commons and commons not included.
- Advice to the National Park Authority over signage issues, gates/stiles etc for open access land.
- Advising the National Park Authority on the implementation of measures aimed at minimising the effects of motorised vehicles on RUPPs, including an Action Plan/Protocol for dealing with conflicts on RUPPs
- The setting of priorities for year one of the implementation of the Rights of Way Improvement Plan (RoWIP) Chapter.
- The mapping of permissive footpaths and bridleways and inclusion on the National Park Authority's website (subject to agreements having been drawn up with landowners).
- Sports and other recreational activities.
