Summary of the Local Development Documents

Core Strategy

A Development Plan Document which sets out Exmoor National Park Authority's spatial vision and over-arching objectives, including those for minerals and waste, together with targets for development of affordable housing and of brown-field land.

The Core Strategy will be prepared in concert with the review of the Exmoor National Park Management Plan. Early stages of consultation on the two documents, together with elements of the sustainability appraisal will be combined. The results of this combined consultation will be fed into the Core Strategy or Management Plan, or both, as appropriate.

Development Control Policies

A set of development control policies to provide the criteria to guide decisions on planning applications and appeals. This document will supersede all the policies of the Local Plan which have not previously been replaced by Development Plan Documents (this is expected to be most of them).

The full range of stakeholders, including North Devon and West Somerset District Councils and Devon and Somerset County Councils, local residents and businesses, Parish Councils, and other affected parties will be fully consulted.

Design Guide

A Supplementary Planning Document which will encourage and facilitate high standards of design for development. The Design Guide will present examples and advice on wide range of design issues, and in particular addressing issues of landscape/scenery, affordability and sustainability.

Consultees will include local architects, planning agents, builders, residents, businesses, the Exmoor Trust, the Exmoor Society, North Devon and West Somerset District Councils, Parish Councils, Somerset Trust for Sustainable Development, etc.

Energy Sustainability Guidance (including renewable energy)

A Supplementary Planning Document which provides advice and detailed considerations giving effect to the policies in the 'saved' Local Plan, in order to promote use and generation of renewable energy and to ensure that renewable energy developments are sensitive to the landscape and environmental qualities of the National Park.

A wide range of relevant stakeholders will be fully consulted, including Greater Exmoor Network for Renewable Energy, Devon and Somerset County Councils, West Somerset and North Devon District Councils; private businesses such as Hydrogeneration Ltd, Wood Energy Ltd, Eco-Exmoor Ltd, Element Energies Ltd, and Good Energy; voluntary/not-for-profit organisations such as South West Wood Fuels Ltd, Devon Association for Renewable Energy, Trans-SEND, and Forum 21; and local residents and communities.
