


Kentisbury Parish – Preliminary Findings


Questionnaires returned following consultation on 24th November 2009.


The event was well attended and 20 survey forms were handed out. Of these, 15 were returned by people wanting affordable local housing in the Kentisbury, Arlington and Loxhore area. Charts showing results of each question are as follows:-














Rural Housing Enabler's Comments and Recommendations

This survey supports the need for up to 15 new affordable homes across a range of parishes.

A scheme is being proposed in Bratton Fleming that could house people with a local connection from adjoining parishes.

Kentisbury would be a good location for a scheme covering that parish and others which do not adjoin Bratton Fleming.

Both locations could house people in need currently living in the adjoining rural area of the National Park identified through the ENPA LDF Survey 2008.

On this basis, it is recommended that the following affordable houses be provided:

Kentisbury 8 homes Bratton Fleming 5 homes

Identifying Housing Need in Kentisbury Parish
