ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 22BB (AS AMENDED)

PUBLIC BRIDLEWAY DU 10/38, PARISH OF WITHYPOOL AND HAWKRIDGE
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that **EXMOOR NATIONAL PARK AUTHORITY** intends to make an Order under Section 22BB of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers. The Order is being made because of the likelihood of danger to the public using Public Bridleway DU 10/38, due to the construction of a new bridge.

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit all traffic from using part of Public Bridleway DU 10/38 between SS 8593 3275 and SS 8571 3395, that is more particularly described in the order and shown on the plan attached to it.

The Order will come into force on 31st May 2024 and will remain in force for six months.

A permitted footpath which runs along the eastern bank of the River Barle between SS 8596 3275 and SS 8574 3389 and carries the Two Moors Way promoted walking route will also be closed. Alternative routes for walkers and riders will be signed on the ground.
