Main Activity:

The mill, along with its forge, workshop and displays provide an interesting attraction for the village of Timberscombe and the Exmoor region. The mill has a working water wheel that drives woodworking machines. There is also a substantial collection of agricultural and industrial machines and tools, displayed as a private collection, which is open to the public, free of charge, by appointment or on regularly advertised open days.
