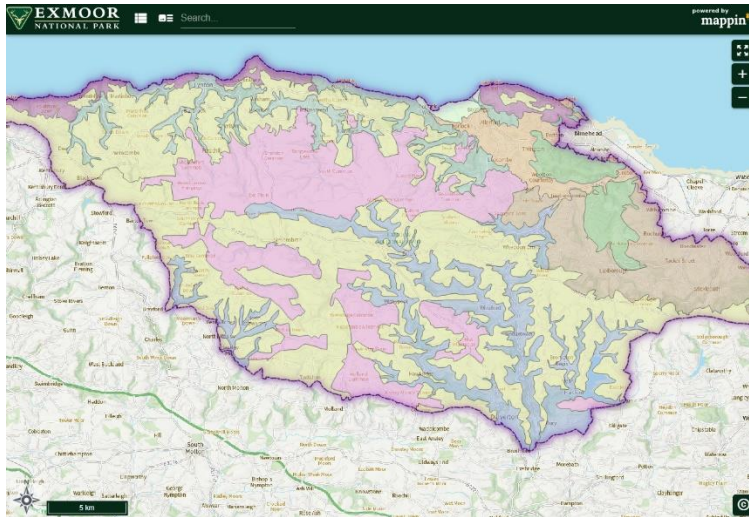

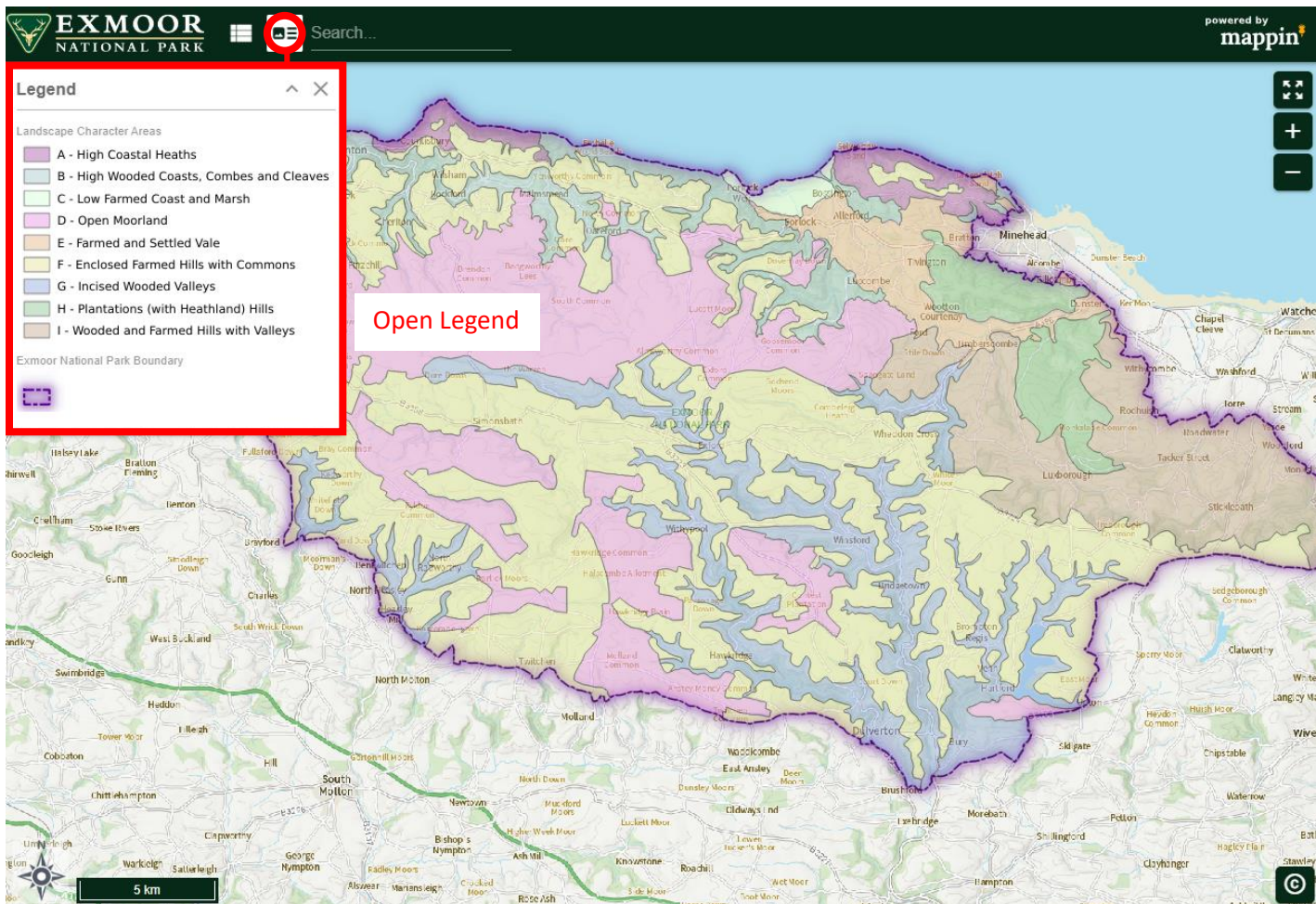


## Landscape Character Map help pages



Clicking on any of the landscape character areas on the interactive map will bring up its name, landscape type, a link to its description and a link to planning policy.

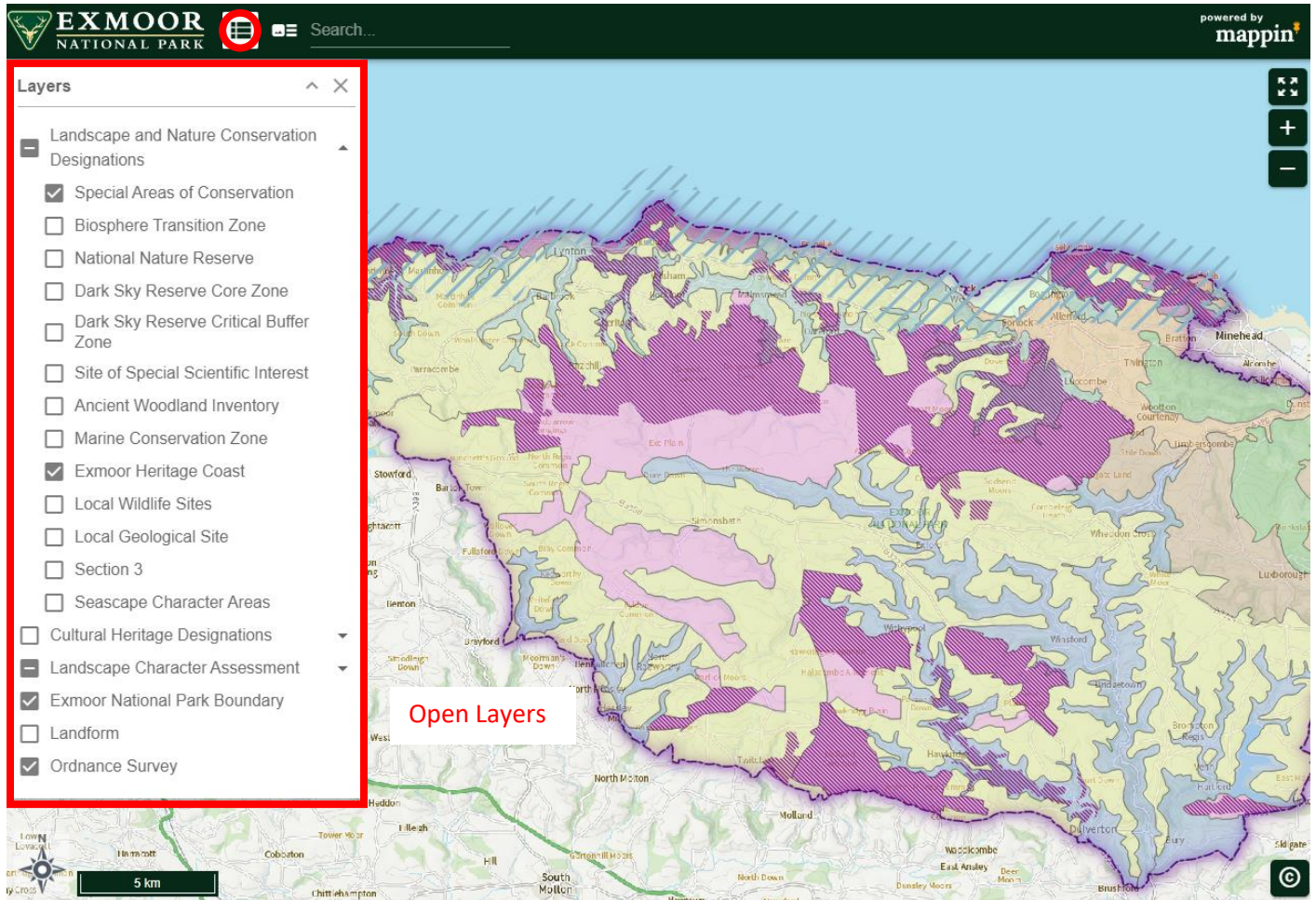
On ones that are on a boundary you will have to zoom in, otherwise you will get both types.

What are the other aspects of the mapping panel called?

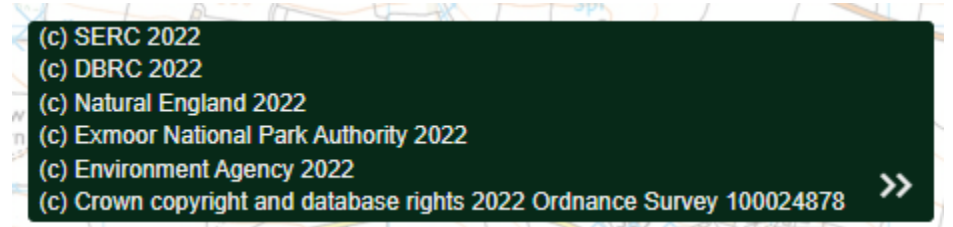

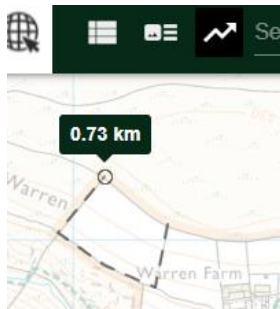

Measure:

Use left mouse button to start, it measures lengths in kilometers at the moment. We will be upgrading to areas at some point. To finish double click the left mouse button.



What is also possible is to turn various layers on at will during the process, as the map layers work independently to that of using the pre-configured button views.

## Search:

If you type next to the measure tool this searches the database for relevant matches, on this occasion I choose Brendon Farm, 2 matches as you can see.

They are represented with a symbol.

Either click in the results search or zoom in to view the results.

To make use of the information behind the scenes you can **click** anywhere on the map to reveal information about the layers that are displayed. For example:

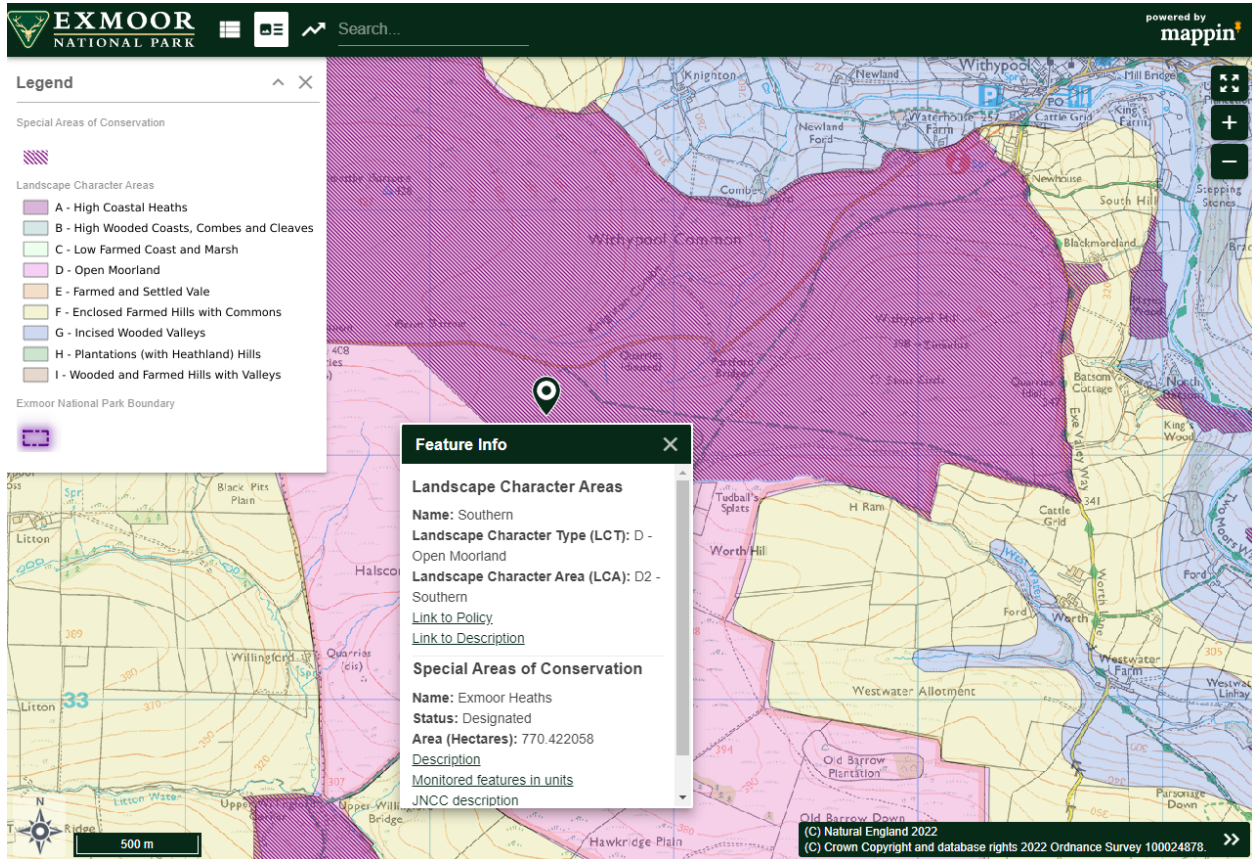
