Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1971

Land at Hartford Lodge, Brompton Regis

WHEREAS the Somerset County Council by virtue of the provisions of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1971 as amended by the Local Government Act, 1972, is the Planning Authority for the Exmoor National Park (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") is satisfied that it is expedient that the development set out in the Schedule hereto should not be undertaken on land forming Ordnance Survey Plots 5735, 7027, 8422, 8231, 9328 (part), 0025 and 9619 on Somerset Sheets 9529 (1970 Edition) and 9629 (1982 Edition) at Hartford Bottom in the Parish of Brompton Regis and shown edged red on the plan annexed hereto unless permission is granted therefor on an application made under the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1977, as amended.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in pursuance of the powers conferred on it by Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1977 HEREBY DIRECTS that the permission granted by Article 3 of the aforesaid Order shall not apply to development on the said land of the description set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

The carrying out on agricultural land having an area of more than one acre and comprised in an agricultural unit of building or engineering operation requisite for the use of that land for the purposes of agriculture, being development comprised within paragraphs 1, 3 and 4 of Class VI of Schedule 1 of the said Order of 1977 and not being development comprised within any other Class.
